1290 CHAPTER 1 18 Edw 1

## III <sup>X1</sup>Mortmain prohibited.

..... <sup>F1</sup> And It is to wit, that this Statute extendeth but only to Lands [<sup>X2</sup>holden] in Fee Simple; and that it extendeth to the time coming; and it shall begin to take effect at the Feast of Saint Andrew the Apostle next coming. [Given the eighteenth year of the Reign of King Edward, Son to King Henry.]

Et si ptem alioq eadē fraz seu ten suoz alioq venderit, feoffatus illi tenent immediate de Cap dno & omitter statim de s'vicio qntum pnter sive pnter debet eidem dno p p'icula illa, scdm qntitatem terre seu ten vendit. Et sic in hoc casu, decelat Cap dno ipa p s'vicia [suspenda p manu feoffatoris], et quo feoffatus debet eidem Cap dno jax qntitatem terre seu ten vendit de p'icula illa s'vicia sic debiti esse intendens & respondens. . . .<sup>1</sup> Et sci qd istud statutu locū tenet de terris venditis tenendis in feodo simpli tantū f&c; Et qd si extendit ad tempus futuri; Et recipiet locū rōle ad Festū scti Andree proximo futuri. &c.
