#### 1297 CHAPTER 1 25 Edw 1

### I No Tallage or Aid without Assent of Parliament.

No Tallage or Aid shall be  $[^{x_1}$ taken] or levied by Us or our Heirs in our Realm, without the good will and Assent of  $(^{x_2})$  Archbishops, Bishops, Earls, Barons, Knights, Burgesses, and other  $[^{x_3}$ Freemen of the Land.]
