

Tithe Act 1536 (repealed)

1536 CHAPTER 11 28 Hen 8

IV Incumbents may devise Profits of Corn sown on their Glebe.

PROVYDED also that in case eny of the Incumbentes aforsaid happen to dye, and before his death hath caused eny of his glebe landes to be manured and sowen at his propre costes and charges with any corne or grayne, that then in that case all and every of the same Incumbentes may make and declare their testamentes of all the profites of the corne growyng uppon the same glebe landes so manured and sowen; any thyng conteyned in this present Acte in any wise notwithstandyng.
