1542 CHAPTER 26 34 and 35 Hen 8

LII Goods of Felons, Waifs, Strays, &c. to the King.

Item, That the Kings Majestie shall have all . . . ^{F1} goods of persones outlawed [^{X1}waif] straiies and all other forfaictures and eschetes whatsoever they be, aunswered therof by thandes of the Shirieffs; Saving alwaies the rights and interests of everye of his subjects having lawfull tytyle to the same.
