## 1708 CHAPTER 21 7 Ann

### V Persons convicted of High Treason, &c. in Scotland, liable as in England.

And  $\dots$  <sup>F1</sup> all Persons convicted  $\dots$  <sup>F2</sup> of High Treason or Misprision of High Treason in Scotland shall be subject and liable to the same  $\dots$  <sup>F1</sup> Penalties  $\dots$  <sup>F1</sup> as Persons convicted  $\dots$  <sup>F2</sup> of High Treason or Misprision of High Treason in England
