QUEEN ANNE'S BOUNTY ACT 1714 (REPEALED)

4	All augmented churches, &c. shall be perpetual benefices, and the ministers shall be bodies politick, and shall be enabled to take in perpetuity such lands, &c. Impropiators, &c. of augmented churches, &c. and the rectors, &c. of the mother-churches, are excluded from the benefit of such augmentation, and shall allow the usual pensions, &c. to the ministers officiating.
5	No rectors, &c. &c. of mother-churches to be discharged from cure of souls.
6	Augmented cures remaining void six months shall lapse to the bishop, &c.

21	Lands, &c. allotted to any church, &c. by deed under the governors seal, shall go in succession, &c.
