CHAPTER 48

LIFE ASSURANCE ACT 1774

- [1.] No Insurance to be made on the lives of persons having no interest, &c.
- 2 No policies on lives without inserting the persons names, &c.
- 3 How much may be recovered where the insured hath interest in lives.
- 4 Not to extend to insurances on ships, goods, &c.
