CHAPTER 49

SUNDAY OBSERVANCE ACT 1780 (REPEALED)

- [1.] House, &c. opened on a Sunday, to which persons shall be admitted by payment, &c, shall be deemed a disorderly house, &c.
 The person who acts as master or mistress in any such house shall be
 - deemed the owner thereof. All houses where refreshments are sold at greater prices on Sundays than on other days, &c. liable to the penalties inflicted by this Act.
