1786 CHAPTER 31 26 Geo 3

## 14 Who shall be commissioners.

And the speaker of the House of Commons, the chancellor of his Majesty's Exchequer, the master of the rolls, [<sup>F1</sup>the Accountant-General of the Supreme Court] and the governor and deputy governor of the Bank of England for the time being respectively shall be commissioners for carrying into execution the purposes of this Act; . . . <sup>F2</sup>
