SECOND SCHEDULE

PROCEDURE FOR MAKING ORDERS, &C.

- 10 The order shall be laid as soon as possible before both Houses of the Parliament of Northern Ireland, and, if either House within the next forty days^{F1} after the order has been laid before that House resolve that all or any of the provisions of the order ought to be annulled, the order shall, after the date of the resolution, be of no effect, without prejudice to the validity of anything done in the meantime thereunder or to the making of any new order. If any of the provisions of an order are annulled, the Ministry may, if it thinks fit, withdraw the whole order.
