1923 CHAPTER 8

1 Consent of young person to be no defence.

 $^{\rm F1}$ It shall be no defence to a charge or indictment for an indecent assault on a child or young person under the age of [$^{\rm F2}$ seventeen] to prove that he or she consented to the act of indecency.
