

Game Preservation Act (Northern Ireland) 1928

1928 CHAPTER 25

- Sale of game taken unlawruny

 [F17AA]

 (1) A person is guilty of an offence if he sells or offers or exposes for sale or has in his temperate for the purposes of sale any game
 - which has been taken or killed in circumstances which constitute an offence under this Act, any of the enactments listed in the Schedule or the Wildlife (Northern Ireland) Order 1985; and
 - which that person knows or has reason to believe has been so taken or killed.
 - (2) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1) is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months or to both.]]
