



# Control of Greyhounds etc. Act (Northern Ireland) 1950

## 1950 CHAPTER 13

### **1 Greyhounds not to be in a public place unless controlled and muzzled.**

- (1) A person shall not exercise or lead or cause or permit to be exercised, led or at large a greyhound in any street, road, highway or other public place or in any place to which the public have or are permitted to have access, other than<sup>F1</sup> premises on which dog trials take place or a track on which dog races of any description take place and for which a track betting licence within the meaning of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985 is in force], unless such greyhound is both under control and muzzled.
- (2) Any person who acts in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this section shall be guilty of an offence under this Act.
