#### **1951 CHAPTER 20**

#### PART II F1

LUMP SUMS AND WIDOWS' AND CHILDREN'S PENSIONS

SPECIAL CASES

### 12 Persons serving again after retirement.

Where any person after retirement from service resumes<sup>F1</sup>... service, that retirement shall be left out of account for all the purposes of this Part of this Act except that—

- (a) if a lump sum was granted on that retirement without any contribution being made, then unless that person on resumption of f. . . service, or within three months of marrying for forming a civil partnership while again serving, refunds by way of contribution one half of the lump sum, no pension shall be granted to any fundow, widower for surviving civil partner for child of that person; and
- (b) any lump sum granted on that retirement, less any refund, shall be set off against any lump sum to be granted in respect of [FI] that person's] service.
