PROVISIONS WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN SUMMARY OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

28 Amendment of the Summary Jurisdiction (Ireland) Act, 1851.

- (1) A person convicted by a court of summary jurisdiction of an offence under—
- (a) paragraphs 1, 3, 5, 8, 10 and 11 of section ten,
 - (b) section twelve,
 - (c) paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 of section thirteen,
- of the Summary Jurisdiction (Ireland) Act, 1851, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds, and accordingly ... *residue amends ss.10,12,13 of 1851 c.92*

Subs. (2) amends s. 14 of 1851 c. 92
