DISTRIBUTION ON INTESTACY

10 Rights of brothers and sisters and their issue.

- (1) If an intestate dies leaving neither issue nor parent, his estate shall, subject to the right of the surviving spouse[FI] or civil partner], if any, be distributed between his brothers and sisters in equal shares, and if any brother or sister predeceases the intestate the surviving issue of the deceased brother or sister shall take *per stirpes* the share that brother or sister would have taken if he or she had survived the intestate.
- (2) If an intestate dies leaving neither issue nor parent nor brother nor sister, his estate shall, subject to the rights of the surviving spouse[FI] or civil partner], if any, be distributed *per stirpes* among the issue of his brothers and sisters.
