

Inheritance (Family Provision) Act (Northern Ireland) 1960

1960 CHAPTER 15

An Act to amend the law relating to dispositions of estates of deceased persons; and for purposes connected therewith. [20th December 1960]

The Act has been repealed subject to savings for—

- (a) applications made thereunder for financial provision out of the estate of any person who died before 1.9.1979; and
- (b) orders made and directions given thereunder which were in force at 1.9.1979
