TIMES OF FISHING FOR SALMON, TROUT, POLLEN AND EELS

WEEKLY CLOSE TIME FOR SALMON AND TROUT CAUGHT OTHERWISE THAN BY ROD AND LINE

## 97 Weekly close time.

In this Act the expression "the weekly close time" means, in relation to any locality, the period prescribed by [F1regulations] as such for that locality, or if no period is prescribed, the period commencing at 6 o'clock a.m. on each Saturday and ending at 6 o'clock a.m. on the then next-following Monday.
