1967 CHAPTER 18

12 Trial of offences committed within admiralty jurisdiction.

- (1) Subject to the provisions of any enactment passed before the commencement of this Act and not repealed or amended by this Act ...^{F1}, any offence which is triable in Northern Ireland by virtue of any jurisdiction in admiralty shall be triable on indictment and section 7 of the Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1945 as amended by this Act shall apply accordingly.
