



# Livestock Marketing Commission Act (Northern Ireland) 1967

## 1967 CHAPTER 21

### 6 Classification of meat.

*Subs.(1) amends s.6 of 1962 c.13 (NI)*

- (2) Regulations made by the Ministry under section 6 of that Act<sup>F1</sup> may contain provisions requiring the owner of the carcasses of any livestock at the time at which those carcasses are classified or graded in pursuance of regulations made under that section to pay to such person as may be specified in the regulations such fee as may be prescribed by the regulations in respect of the classification or grading.
- (3) Regulations made by the Ministry under section 6 of that Act<sup>F1</sup> may include provisions making persons guilty of an offence where there is a contravention of the regulations, and for the imposition of penalties on summary conviction of such an offence, but so that a maximum fine and a maximum term of imprisonment specified in the regulations shall not exceed<sup>F2</sup> level 3 on the standard scale] and six months, respectively.
