OFFICERS

42 Councillors not to be appointed officers.

- F1(1) Subject to subsection (2), a person shall, so long as he is and for twelve months after he has ceased to be, a councillor, be disqualified for being appointed by the council to any paid office [F2which is prescribed under section 4(1)(a)].
- (3) In this section—
 - "council" includes a committee or sub-committee of a council;
 - "councillor" includes a member of such a committee or sub-committee, whether he is a member of the council or not.
