SCHEDULE 7  
FORM OF NOTICE INTIMATING APPLICATION  
TO LANDS TRIBUNAL UNDER SECTION 20(1)

*Notes for completion of the notice*

- 4 The superiority referred to in the box “Title to the superiority” is the superiority of land which comprises the prospective servient tenement.

Where the title—

- (a) has been registered in the Land Register and the applicant is infeft, specify the title number or if he is uninfefit specify the title number and set out the midcouples or links between the person last infeft and the applicant in such terms as are sufficient to identify them;
- (b) has not been registered in the Land Register and the applicant is infeft, specify by reference to the Register the deed constituting the title or if he is uninfefit specify the deed constituting the title of the person last infeft and the date of recording and set out the midcouples or links as in paragraph (a).
