## SCHEDULE 1 THE STANDARDS COMMISSION FOR SCOTLAND

## Accountable officer

- [F110B(1) The Parliamentary corporation shall designate a member or employee of the Commission as the accountable officer for the purposes of this paragraph.
  - (2) The functions of the accountable officer are—
    - (a) signing the accounts of the expenditure and receipts of the Commission;
    - (b) ensuring the propriety and regularity of the finances of the Commission;
    - (c) ensuring that the resources of the Commission are used economically, efficiently and effectively; and
    - (d) the duty set out in sub-paragraph (3).
  - (3) Where the accountable officer is required to act in some way but considers that to do so would be inconsistent with the proper exercise of the functions specified in subparagraph (2)(a) to (c), the accountable officer shall—
    - (a) obtain written authority from the Commission before taking the action; and
    - (b) send a copy of the authority as soon as possible to the Auditor General for Scotland.
  - (4) The accountable officer is answerable to the Parliament for the performance of the functions in sub-paragraph (2).]
