

Prohibition of Female Genital Mutilation (Scotland) Act 2005

6 Definitions

In this Act—

"United Kingdom national" is an individual who is—

- (a) a British citizen, a British overseas territories citizen, a British National (Overseas) or a British Overseas citizen;
- (b) a person who under the British Nationality Act 1981 (c. 61) is a British subject; or
- (c) a British protected person within the meaning of that Act;

 $[^{F1}$ 'United Kingdom resident" is an individual who is habitually resident in the United Kingdom.]
