General

22 Short title, Crown application and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Scottish Commission for Human Rights Act 2006.
- (2) This Act binds the Crown.
- (3) This Act (except section 21 and this section) comes into force on such day as Her Majesty may by Order in Council appoint.
- (4) An Order in Council under subsection (3) may-
 - (a) appoint different days for different purposes, and
