27 Amount and payment of fixed penalty

- (1) The Scottish Ministers may by order prescribe a scale of fixed penalties for the purposes of sections 25 to 31, the amount of the maximum penalty on the scale being a sum not exceeding [^{F1}£10,000.]
- (2) The "appropriate fixed penalty" means such fixed penalty on the scale prescribed under subsection (1) as the [^{F2}fixed penalty] officer thinks fit having regard to the circumstances of the case and any relevant provision of an order under that subsection.
- (3) The fixed penalty is to be payable to the Scottish Ministers, at such address and by such methods as the Scottish Ministers may by order specify.
