[^{F1}Officers of court's] professional association

64 Duty of professional association to forward complaints ^{F1}...

Where the professional association receives a complaint about [F2 an officer of court] or any services provided by the officer, the association must send details of the complaint and any material which accompanies it —

- $[^{F3}(a)$ to the Lord President of the Court of Session;
 - (b) in the case of a complaint about a messenger-at-arms, to the sheriff principal from whom the messenger-at-arms holds a commission as a sheriff officer; and
 - (c) in the case of a complaint about a sheriff officer, to the sheriff principal from whom the sheriff officer holds a commission.]
