JUDICIAL APPOINTMENTS

[^{F1}Other Court of Session judges

[^{F1}20G Remuneration and expenses of temporary and former judges

- (1) The Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service ("the SCTS") is to pay to an individual appointed under section 20B(1) or 20E(1) such remuneration [^{F2}and such allowances] as the Scottish Ministers may determine.
- (2) The Scottish Ministers may determine different amounts of remuneration [^{F3}and different amounts of allowances] for—
 - (a) different individuals so appointed, or
 - (b) different descriptions of individuals so appointed.
- (3) The SCTS may pay to an individual appointed under section 20B(1) or 20E(1) such sums as it may determine in respect of expenses reasonably incurred by the individual in the performance of, or in connection with, the individual's duties.
- (4) The SCTS may-
 - (a) determine the circumstances in which such sums may be paid, and
 - (b) determine different circumstances for different individuals.]
