DISCLOSURE

General

163 Contravention of section 162

- (1) A person who knowingly uses or discloses information in contravention of section 162 commits an offence.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1) is liable—
 - (a) on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months or to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum or to both,
 - (b) on conviction on indictment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years or to a fine or to both.
