

Carer's Allowance Supplement (Scotland) Act 2021

PROSPECTIVE

2 Power to increase amount of carer's allowance supplement

The Social Security (Scotland) Act 2018 is amended as follows—

- (a) in section 81, after subsection (4B) insert—
 - "(4C) The Scottish Ministers may by regulations modify this section so as to provide that the amount of a carer's allowance supplement in respect of such period as may be specified in the regulations is an amount greater than the amount calculated according to the formula in subsection (4).",
- (b) in section 96 (regulation-making powers), in subsection (2), for "81(8)" substitute "81(4C) and (8)".
