Provision of advice etc. to the Scottish Ministers

65 Provision of advice etc. to the Scottish Ministers

- (1) The [^{F1}SCTS] may give information or advice, or make proposals, to the Scottish Ministers on matters relating to—
 - (a) the functions of the [^{F1}SCTS], or
 - (b) the administration of justice in Scotland.
- (2) The Scottish Ministers must have regard to such information, advice or proposals.
- (3) This section is without prejudice to paragraph 15(2)(c) of schedule 3.
