SCHEDULE 5 APPOINTMENT TO UPPER TRIBUNAL

PART 2

LEGAL MEMBERS

Appointment and eligibility

- 4 (1) It is for the Scottish Ministers to appoint a person as a legal member of the Upper Tribunal.
- (2) A person is eligible for such appointment only if qualifying under paragraph 5(1) or (2).
