

Wild Animals in Travelling Circuses (Scotland) Act 2018 2018 asp 3

Offence and what it covers

4 Power to specify animals as wild or not

- (1) The Scottish Ministers may by regulations specify—
 - (a) a kind of animal that is to be regarded as wild,
 - (b) a kind of animal that is not to be regarded as wild, for the purposes of this Act.
- (2) For the avoidance of doubt—
 - (a) whatever is done by regulations under subsection (1)(a) is without prejudice to the generality of section 2,
 - (b) the generality of section 2 is subject to whatever is done by regulations under subsection (1)(b).
- (3) Regulations under this section—
 - (a) may make different provision for different purposes,
 - (b) are subject to the affirmative procedure.
