The Alien and Locally Absent Species (Aquaculture) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020

Made - - - - 2020

Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 1

The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs(1) makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 11 of, and Part 1C of Schedule 2 to, the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018(2).

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as The Alien and Locally Absent Species (Aquaculture) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020 and shall come into operation on IP completion day.

(2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(3) applies to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.

Amendment of the Alien and Locally Absent Species in Aquaculture Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2012

2.—(1) The Alien and Locally Absent Species in Aquaculture Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2012(**4**) are amended as follows.

(2) In regulations 4(2)(b) and 6(1)(b) omit "or to Northern Ireland from another part of the United Kingdom".
