MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS OF THE FOYLE
FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1952

Forfeiture of boats, fishing engines, etc.

28.—(1) In section 75 of the 1952 Act (forfeiture), for the words from “any fish” to the end of that section there shall be substituted “the court by which he is convicted may make such other order as to the forfeiture of—

- (a) any fish illegally taken by him or in his possession at the time of the offence;
- (b) any boat, fishing engine, equipment or any other thing by means or in respect of which the offence is committed,

as the court thinks fit.”

(2) Section 76 of the 1952 Act (recording of forfeiture) shall cease to have effect.
