**The Foot and Mouth Disease (Amendment)  
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014**

*Made* - - - - *30th May 2014*

*Coming into operation* *1st July 2014*

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development<sup>(1)</sup>, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(2)</sup>, makes the following Regulations.

**Citation and Commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as The Foot and Mouth Disease (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 1st July 2014.

**Interpretation**

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954<sup>(3)</sup> shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

**Amendment**

3. The Foot and Mouth Disease Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006<sup>(4)</sup> are amended as follows—

- (a) In regulation 15(1), for words “a contemporary control zone” substitute “a temporary control zone”;
- (b) In regulation 30(4)—
  - (i) For sub-paragraph (b), substitute “any protection zone extends from that border such that its boundary is at least three kilometres from the infected premises”; and
