**The National Health Service (Charges for Drugs and Appliances) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2001**

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 69(1) and (2), 75A(1), 105(7) and 108(1) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(1), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c. 46).
