**The Potatoes Originating in Egypt  
(Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2006**

*Made* - - - - 24th January 2006  
*Laid before the Scottish  
Parliament* - - - - 26th January 2006  
*Coming into force* - - 28th February 2006

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Potatoes Originating in Egypt (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2006 and shall come into force on 28th February 2006.

**Amendment of the Potatoes Originating in Egypt (Scotland) Regulations 2004**

2.—(1) The Potatoes Originating in Egypt (Scotland) Regulations 2004<sup>(2)</sup> are amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In regulation 2 (interpretation), in paragraph (1), at the end of the definition of “the Decision” insert “and as further amended by Commission Decision [2005/840/EC](#)”<sup>(3)</sup>.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations implement in Scotland Commission Decision [2005/840/EC](#) (O.J. No. L 312, 29.11.05, p.63) amending Commission Decision [2004/4/EC](#) (“the principal Decision”) (O.J. No. L 2, 6.1.04, p.50) authorising Member States temporarily to take emergency measures against the dissemination of *Pseudomonas solanacearum* (Smith) Smith (now referred to as *Ralstonia solanacearum* (Smith) Yabuuchi et al.) as regards Egypt.

The Regulations amend regulation 2(1) of the Potatoes Originating in Egypt (Scotland) Regulations 2004 ([S.S.I. 2004/111](#)). The Regulations insert, into the definition of the principal Decision, Commission Decision [2005/840/EC](#) which amends the principal Decision (regulation 2). Decision [2005/840/EC](#) renews the framework within which potatoes may be imported from Egypt into the territory of the European Community during the 2005/2006 season.

No Regulatory Impact Assessment has been carried out in respect of the extension of these controls to the 2005/2006 season.
