**The Housing Revenue Account General Fund
Contribution Limits (Scotland) Order 2007**

Made - - - - 8th February 2007
*Laid before the Scottish
Parliament* - - - - 15th February 2007
Coming into force - - 15th March 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 204 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Revenue Account General Fund Contribution Limits (Scotland) Order 2007 and shall come into force on 15th March 2007.

General fund contribution limits

2. The amount of contribution out of its general fund which a local authority may estimate that it will carry to the credit of its housing revenue account for the year 2007–2008 shall be limited to nil.
