The Additional Support for Learning (Sources of Information) (Scotland) Order 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 26(2) (i) of the Education (Additional Support for Learning) (Scotland) Act 2004⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Additional Support for Learning (Sources of Information) (Scotland) Order 2010 and comes into force on 16th August 2010.

Publication of information by education authority

2. For the purposes of section 26(2)(i) of the Education (Additional Support for Learning) (Scotland) Act 2004 (power to specify additional sources of information), the persons specified are—

- (a) Children In Scotland: Working for Children and Their Families, trading as “Enquire – the Scottish national advice service for additional support for learning”; and
- (b) The Scottish Independent Advocacy Alliance Limited.
