Citation, commencement and effect

- **1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Firefighters' Pension Scheme (Scotland) Amendment (No. 3) Order 2014.
 - (2) This Order comes into force on 28th June 2014, but—
 - (a) articles 3(b) and 7(a) have effect from 22nd May 2014; and
 - (b) articles 3(a), 5(a), 7(b) and 8 have effect from 23rd May 2014.

Amendment of the Firefighters' Pension Scheme (Scotland) Order 2007

2. Schedule 1 to the Firefighters' Pension Scheme (Scotland) Order 2007(2) is amended in accordance with articles 3 to 5.

 - (b) omit the definition of "the Scheme Actuary".
- **4.** In Part 11 (pensionable pay, pension contributions and purchase of additional service)—
 - (a) in rule 6A (election to purchase service during the limited period)—
 - (i) in paragraph (2)(a), omit "his";
 - (ii) in paragraph (4), omit "his";
 - (iii) in paragraph (5), for "his" substitute "the member's"; and
 - (iv) in paragraph (6), omit "his"; and
 - (b) in paragraph (7) of rule 6B (election to purchase service during the limited period: supplemental provision), for "he" substitute "the member".
- 5. In Part 12 (transfers into and out of the Scheme)—
 - (a) in paragraph (3) of rule 11A (transfer of accrued rights under the 1992 Scheme to special membership of this scheme), for "rule 5(13)" substitute "rule 5A(13) of Part 11"; and
 - (b) in rule 18 (converting membership from standard membership to special membership special pensioner members)—
 - (i) in paragraph (5), omit "his";
 - (ii) in paragraph (6)(b), after "his" (where it first occurs) insert "or her"; and
 - (iii) in paragraph (6)(b), omit "his" (where it second occurs).

Amendment of the Firefighters' Pension Scheme (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Order 2014
