**PUBLIC RECORDS**

**The Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011  
(Authorities) Amendment Order 2018**

*Made* - - - - - *9th January 2018*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *12th January 2018*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 2(2) of the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 2(8) of that Act, a draft of this Order has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament<sup>(2)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011 (Authorities) Amendment Order 2018 and comes into force on 12th January 2018.

**Amendments to the schedule to the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011**

2. In the schedule of the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011 (authorities to which Part 1 of that Act applies), under the heading “Others”, in the appropriate place according to alphabetical order, add the following entries—

“First-tier Tribunal for Scotland”; and

“Upper Tribunal for Scotland”.

Part 1 of that Act makes provision for records management plans.
