6 Board to be consulted in certain cases.

- (1) Without prejudice to section 13(1) of the 1988 Act, a local education authority shall consult the Board for any diocese in which the authority exercises its functions before appointing a person to represent the Church of England as a member of a standing advisory council on religious education under section 11 of that Act.
- (2) Before making any modifications of a trust deed or other instrument relating to a church school by order under section [^{F1}136 of the Education Act 1993] the Secretary of State shall consult the Board for the diocese in which the school is situated, as well as the persons with whom consultation is required by subsection (1) of that section.
