6 Board to be consulted in certain cases.

- (1) Without prejudice to [^{F1}section 392(2) of the Education Act 1996], a local education authority shall consult the Board for any diocese in which the authority exercises its functions before appointing a person to represent the Church of England as a member of a standing advisory council on religious education under [^{F1}section 390] of that Act.
