### **1964 CHAPTER 40**

Exchequer Assistance for Execution of harbour Works, &c.

# 13 Maximum amount of loans and grants under sections 11 and 12, and cesser of certain other powers to give financial assistance.

- (2) No advance shall be made after the passing of this Act under section 17(1) of the <sup>MI</sup>Ministry of Transport Act 1919 by the Minister for the construction, improvement or maintenance of a harbour, dock or pier, and no advance or loan shall be made—
  - (a) under section 3 of the <sup>M2</sup>Harbours and Passing Tolls, &c. Act 1861...<sup>F2</sup>by the [<sup>F3</sup>Treasury] for carrying any shipping purpose into effect at a harbour which is not for the time being a fishery harbour or marine work;
  - (b) .....<sup>F4</sup>
