#### MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

*Provisions relating to orders made by magistrates' courts in matrimonial proceedings*

**30 Order for maintenance of party to marriage made by magistrates' court to cease to have effect on remarriage of that party.**

(1) . . . . .<sup>F1</sup>

(2) [<sup>F2</sup>Section 4(2) of the Domestic Proceedings and Magistrates' Courts Act 1978] shall apply in relation to an order consisting of or including a provision such as is mentioned in [<sup>F2</sup>section 2(1)(a)] of that Act made by [<sup>F3</sup>the family court] and confirmed in accordance with section 3 of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act 1920 (which enables [<sup>F3</sup>the family court] to make a maintenance order against a person resident in a part of Her Majesty's dominions outside the United Kingdom but provides that the order shall have no effect unless and until confirmed by a competent court in that part) [<sup>F2</sup>as it applies in relation to an order made under section 2(1)(a) of the Domestic Proceedings and Magistrates' Courts Act 1978], . . .<sup>F4</sup>
