

Marriage (Scotland) Act 1977

1977 CHAPTER 15

MINIMUM AGE FOR MARRIAGE

1 Minimum age for marriage.

- (1) No person domiciled in Scotland may marry before he attains the age of 16.
- (2) A marriage solemnised in Scotland between persons either of whom is under the age of 16 shall be void.
