RIGHTS IN PERFORMANCES: PERMITTED ACTS

- 10 (1) Material which is comprised in public records within the meaning of the ^{M1}Public Records Act 1958, the ^{M2}Public Records (Scotland) Act 1937 or the ^{M3}Public Records Act (Northern Ireland) 1923 which are open to public inspection in pursuance of that Act, may be copied, and a copy may be supplied to any person, by or with the authority of any officer appointed under that Act, without infringing any right conferred by Part II.
- (2) Expressions used in this paragraph have the same meaning as in section 49.
