1995 CHAPTER 40

6 Repeals.

- (1) The enactments mentioned in Schedule 5 to this Act are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.
- (2) Without prejudice to section 16(1)(a) of the MIInterpretation Act 1978, the repeal by this Act of the provisions of the M2Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975 specified in Schedule 6 to this Act shall not revive any rule of law or practice having effect before the coming into force of the M3Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1887.
