SCHEDULE 7

THE LAND REGISTRY

Holding of office by Chief Land Registrar

- 1 (1) The registrar may at any time resign his office by written notice to the [^{F1}Secretary of State].
- (2) The [^{F1}Secretary of State] may remove the registrar from office if he is unable or unfit to discharge the functions of office.
- (3) Subject to the above, a person appointed to be the registrar is to hold and vacate office in accordance with the terms of his appointment and, on ceasing to hold office, is eligible for reappointment.
